The Berks County Chiefs' of Police Association is embarking on a new recruiting concept in an attempt to attract the most qualified people to police the streets of Berks County and doing it in a more fiscally responsible manner. Interested candidates may obtain a registration form to participate in the testing process at www.berkspolicechiefs.org. Completed applications, along with a \$50 check or money order must be received at the Association Post Office Box by Friday, Feb. 17, 2012.

Written test scores will be posted on the Association website by Friday, March 2, 2012. Candidates achieving a written score of 70 or higher may proceed to the physical fitness portion of the testing procedure. The date, time and location of the physical fitness test will be posted on the website. The names of candidates passing both segments will be placed on a master police hiring list according to their written score ranking. Participating police departments will develop their individual hiring lists based on a candidate's ranking and on the department's minimum qualifications, such as having Act 120 training prior to employment. Having Act 120 training IS NOT a prerequisite for participating in this process, however, all but three participating departments required this basic police training.

Interested candidates must be US citizens, 21-years of age to be hired, have at least a high school diploma or GED and possess a valid driver's license.
