The Chief's Association will rank candidates based on the results of the written and physical fitness tests. When a municipality decides to hire officers, the Association will provide a list of candidates based on that department's minimum requirements. For example, a department requiring candidates to have Act 120 basic police training prior to employment will only be given those candidate's names fulfilling that requirement.

NOTE: Candidate appeals of results for written and fitness test must be made through each individual agency that candidate has checked off.
